#### **INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE**

The **Anchor BCI Equity Fund** is a general equity portfolio that seeks to sustain high long-term capital growth.

# INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

The portfolio is constructed from bottom-up, fundamental research with an investment philosophy that favours quality stocks with superior returns on capital, cash flows and pricing power. While acceptable valuation is an important component of the stock-selection process, the fund's style is not "value"—investments will be made in premium-rated stocks where the growth outlook and quality profile warrants it. The fund will also own shares that are often not well researched, yet offer exceptional valuation-driven opportunities. The quality of companies included is judged by rates of earnings growth, return on capital employed, cash conversion and stability of margins. The portfolio may, from time to time, invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may include the following unlisted financial instruments: forward currency, interest rate and exchange-rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes. The portfolio's equity exposure will always exceed 80% of the portfolio's net asset value.

- Therefore, it is suitable for long term investment horizons.

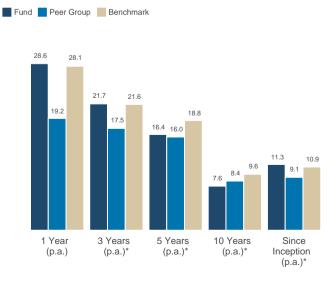
# FUND PERFORMANCE SINCE INCEPTION

Growth of R100 investment (cumulative)



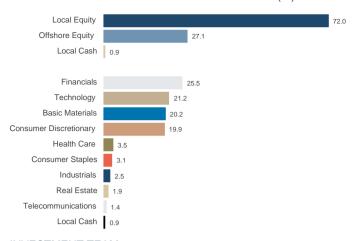

The Anchor BCI Equity Fund ended September 6.3% higher vs the benchmark FTSE/JSE Capped Swix Index, which ended the month up 6.5%. YTD, the fund is up 25.0%. September was the year's best month for South African (SA) equity markets, ending its strongest quarter in over 5 years (FTSE/JSE Capped SWIX Index +12.8% QoQ) and pushing the local bourse to a 31% YTD gain. In what has become a familiar theme for the JSE in 2025, precious metal miners were the major drivers of performance. Platinum (+46% MoM) and gold miners (+27% MoM) were responsible for all of the JSE performance in September, while investment conglomerates Naspers and Prosus (+8% MoM in aggregate) were the other key sources of positive returns, offsetting the collective drag from the remaining counters. The Fund's overweight call on the platinum group metals (PGM) complex (as a result of the addition of Valterra Platinum to the portfolio) has helped offset some of the relative underperformance from being underweight the gold complex. However, the recent upweighting of Harmony Gold has added some welcome alpha in the sector. The Fund was also, fortunately, overweight Anglo American plc going into the announced "merger of equals" with Teck Resources, another interesting twist in the Anglo American saga. Outside of the basic materials sector, the Fund has been gradually adding exposure to SA banks, which we believe are offering good value as we head into the latter part of 2025.
