



INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

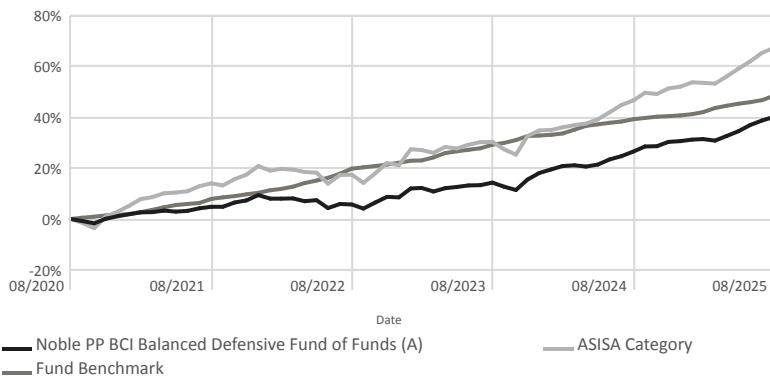
The Noble PP BCI Balanced Defensive Fund of Funds is a moderate managed fund of funds. The primary investment objective of the portfolio is to provide investors with a moderate level of income and capital growth.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The investment policy reflects a spread of investments aimed at income and capital growth normally associated with the investment structure of a retirement fund with a moderate risk profile. The portfolio complies with prudential investment guidelines to the extent allowed for by the Act, subject to a maximum equity exposure of 60% of the portfolio's total assets. Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from money market instruments and cash, consist of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes, or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective, investing in equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares, listed and unlisted financial instruments, bonds and other interest-bearing instruments and securities. **The investment manager manages the portfolio in line with the following internal maximum exposure restrictions: equity: 45%.

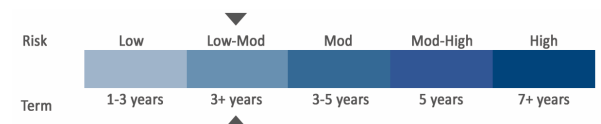

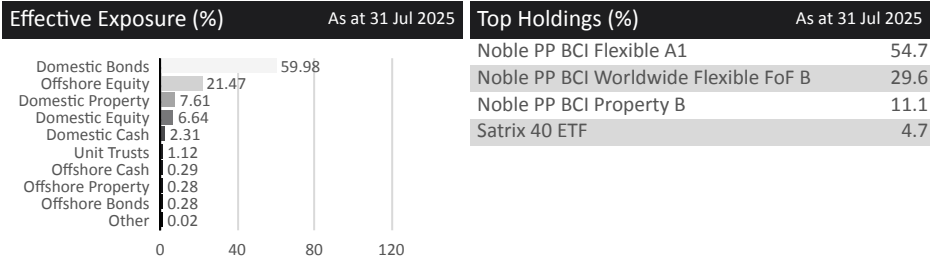
Low - Moderate Risk
